

How to obtain a Transfer Station Sticker

A Transfer Station Sticker can be obtained at the Greenville Town Office or [Transfer Station](#).

How to obtain a transfer station sticker

- You may only be issued a transfer station sticker if you can show proof of residency or property ownership in the Town of Greenville, Harford's Point, Moosehead Jct. Twp, or Big Moose Twp.
- The first two household transfer station stickers are **FREE**. Additional stickers cost \$25 each.
(New stickers are issued every January)
- If you change your license plate, please be sure to notify the Town Office so the appropriate change can be made to your transfer station sticker application.

Acceptable Materials at Transfer Station Include:

All materials must be separated as follows



Municipal Solid Waste (MSW)

Typical household waste. **FREE**

Tires (Rimless)

Tires physically smaller in size than a tractor trailer tire—**\$4.00/tire**
(this includes car and pickup tires, motorcycle tires, yard tractor tires, etc.)

Tires equal or larger in size than a truck tire—**\$10.00/tire**
(this includes tractor-trailer tires)

Skidder Tires—**\$90.00/tire**

Construction Demolition Debris (CDD) - **\$300 per ton (.15¢ per lb.)**

Roofing materials, sheetrock, pressure treated wood, rugs, furniture, large plastics, etc.

Users of the transfer station will be able to purchase a bright orange trash bag at the Greenville Town Office or Transfer Station for **\$10 per 55 gal. orange bag**, into which CDD may be placed. Once full the orange bag may be placed into the CDD dumpsters at the Transfer Station.

(You only pay for the bag there is no additional disposal fee)

Metals/Whitegoods— freezers, refrigerators & air conditioning units must be placed in separate storage piles and kept upright.

Appliances with Freon (Refrigerators, Freezers, Air Conditioners, Etc.) **\$10/each**

Appliances without Freon (Microwaves, Stoves, Clothes Washer, Clothes Dryer, Etc.) **FREE**

Clean Brush or Tree Parts —**FREE**

Propane Tanks

20lb. Propane cylinders with valves intact **\$5/each**

Paint—**FREE**

Paintcare Program

Our Transfer Station participates in the program.

Latex, acrylic, water-based, alkyd, oil-based, enamel paints, deck coatings, floor paints, primers, sealers, undercoaters, stains, shellacs, lacquers, varnishes, urethanes, waterproofing sealers & repellents, metal coatings, rust preventatives, field & lawn paints must be in containers five gallons or smaller. All containers must have lids and original labels.

THERE IS NO FEE FOR DROPPING OFF PAINT & STAINS THROUGH THIS PROGRAM!



Acceptable Recycling Materials at the Transfer Station

Glass

Mixed Paper—Newspaper, Catalogs, Magazines, Junk Mail, Envelopes, Copy Paper, Brown Paper Bags, Egg Cartons, Cereal Boxes, etc.

Plastics—(Please wash) Milk jugs, #1 & #2 plastics

Cardboard—Corrugated cardboard

Tin & Aluminum Cans—(Please wash)

Waste oil is accepted at Dave's Automotive, Porter's Garage & Jack Whittier's Garage

Now accepted at the Transfer Station
